Prevention is KEY!

*Always keep your dog on a traditional leash

*Use a proper fitting Martingale (no slip) collar and/or harness

*Keep ID tags on collars with up to date phone numbers

*Have your dog microchipped and registered with current information

*Do NOT leave your dog unattended outside

*Be conscious of your dog's anxiety triggers (i.e. fireworks, storms, other loud noises)

*Spay/Neuter your pet

Have a lost dog? Follow our
"QUICK ACTION PLAN"

**Immediately contact local Police, Animal Control, Vet's Offices, Shelters in a 20 mile radius.*

**Create and post lost dog flyers on telephone poles in a 3 mile radius. Be sure to include a photo of your lost dog and a phone number that will be answered 24/7.*

**Use social media sites to spread the word about your missing dog.*

**Go look for your dog! Drive the area where your dog went missing. Do NOT scream or chase your lost dog. This will push your dog further away!*

**If you see your dog, remember to carry a leash and smelly food/treats, Get down on the ground, below eye level, and gently throw smelly food/treats their way. This is a non threatening action that can entice the dog to you.*
